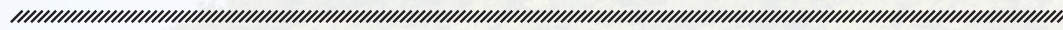

Asheville Brewery Tour with Lunch - \$110.00

After a delicious lunch at a local Asheville establishment, a professional guide will take you on a fun and informative brewery tour. You will be provided with behind-the-scenes brewmaster access, insights into the craft beer brewing process, tastings of many highly acclaimed local beers, and an educated introduction to the diverse brewing scene of Asheville and its beer history. The tour includes a unique collection of tastings at each of the breweries.

Biltmore Estate Day Tour - \$110.00

Visit the Biltmore Estate and America's largest home, a retreat opened in 1895 by George Vanderbilt, the youngest son of an American family famous for its wealth. Traveling worldwide to furnish his home, the 60+ rooms included art by Renoir, Whistler, and Sargent; exquisite 16th-century tapestries; and 24,000 books in seven languages. En route to the Biltmore Estate, your guide will give you a windscreen tour of Downtown Asheville and provide an informative and entertaining background about the history of Asheville, the impact of George Vanderbilt and his Estate on the region, and Asheville's phenomenal Art Deco architecture.

Golf at Grove Park - \$115.00

Swing into a round of golf on the legendary 18-hole course at our Asheville, NC golf resort, The Omni Grove Park Inn & Spa. Donald Ross originally designed this historic course in 1926, and it was overhauled in 2001 to keep the same feel and spirit. The 6,113-yard championship course has been played by PGA stars Bobby Jones, Ben Hogan and Jack Nicklaus, and even President Obama. Feel a sense of pride and accomplishment after navigating the tree-lined fairways and bent greens with amazing views of the Blue Ridge Mountains. Elevated tee boxes on the par 70 course provide perfect sight lines for each drive.

Horseback Riding Excursion - \$140.00

Experience fresh mountain air, breath-taking scenery and old-fashioned down-home friendliness when you go horseback riding in North Carolina's Blue Ridge Mountains. Ride at a secluded ranch just outside of Asheville, with picturesque trails that pass through high country, scenic mountain meadows and wooded areas. This safe and relaxing ride is for people of all ages and horseback riding abilities, and there are no weight limits.
