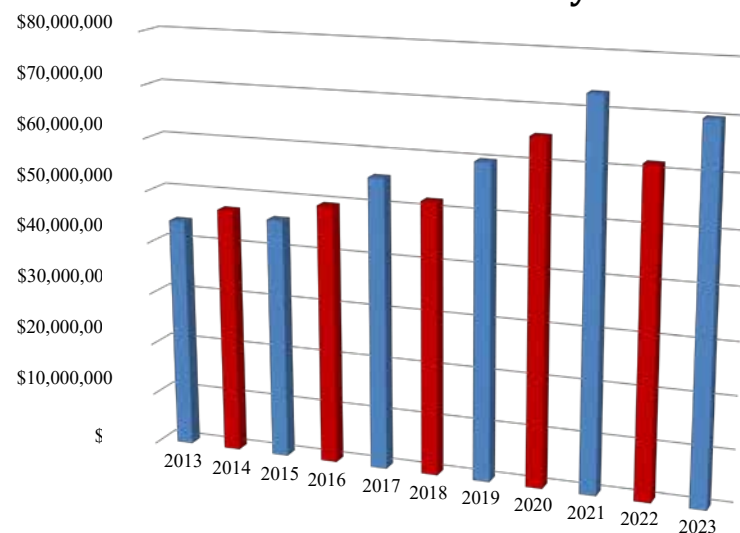

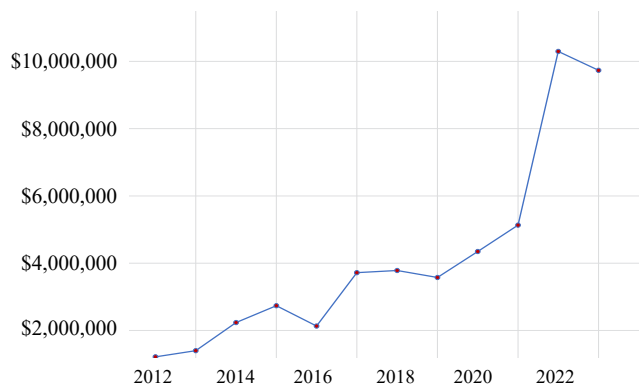
Fund Balance History

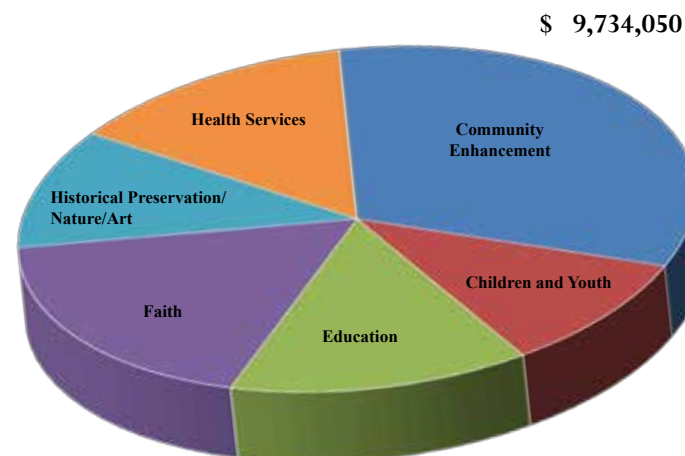
Increase in Grants Distributed to Charities by Year

Guthrie Clinic

The Ferrario Foundation

In 2023, the Guthrie Clinic received a generous contribution from The Ferrario Foundation. Guthrie is a not-for-profit, integrated health care system designed to offer patients a full-spectrum of health services incorporating primary care, complex specialty care, behavioral health services, surgical services, inpatient care, durable medical equipment services, home health, long-term care, palliative care and hospice care. When Dr. Guthrie came to Sayre in 1910, meeting the health care needs of the surrounding communities was the cornerstone of his mission. Academics are also a distinguishing characteristic of the Guthrie organization. The Donald Guthrie Research Foundation was started in 1942 and with funds from the Emily Guthrie Estate, the Guthrie Research Institute was formed in 1980. Guthrie's commitment to learning and education has continued throughout the years. In addition to its longstanding relationship with Robert Packer Hospital, Guthrie acquired Troy Community Hospital in 1985, Corning Hospital in 1999, Towanda Memorial Hospital in 2015, Cortland Medical Center in 2019 and Lourdes Hospital in 2024.



Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition

The Rohrer Brothers Family Foundation

In 1993, women all across Pennsylvania came together to take action in the fight against breast cancer. They had one mission – to help find a cure. The PBCC has contributed nearly \$5 million to breast cancer researchers right here in Pennsylvania, hosts a traveling photo exhibit that emphasizes the importance of early detection, showing the faces of real women across the state with breast cancer, and provides resources and information by sending thousands of free 'Friends Like Me' care packages to newly diagnosed women. Over 46,000 uninsured and underinsured women have received free mammograms, thanks to the efforts of the PBCC, and thousands of women who were diagnosed under the program received free treatment for breast cancer. In 2023, as the Pennsylvania Breast Cancer Coalition celebrated its 30th anniversary, the Rohrer Brothers Family Foundation gave generously to support the organization. Among the many other charities supported by the Rohrer Brothers Family Foundation, they also gave to Testicular Cancer Awareness, Four Diamonds, and the Pulmonary Fibrosis Foundation.



Fulton County Medical Center

The Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation

The Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation has been a long-time supporter of the Fulton County Medical Center and continued to give generously to the health care institution in 2023. The family's philanthropic spirit toward Fulton County Medical Center began in 2002. Since then, they have supported every expansion project and many major equipment purchases, either firsthand or through the family foundation. "We are continuing to do what my dad and mom would have done," says Ken Shockey, whose parents moved to McConnellsburg more than 50 years ago when Paul, an engineer, helped John L. Grove establish JLG Industries. Fulton County Medical Center provides local access to high quality care by continuing to invest in the latest diagnostic and treatment technology. Committed to supporting the local community, the Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation also gave generously to Fulton County Library, Greencastle Area Youth Foundation, Waynesboro Area Gala Cancer Auction, and Summit Health Foundation. Recently, the Franklin County Community Impact Award was presented to Ken and Bonnie Shockey of the Paul K. and Anna E.

Shockey Family Foundation. Since it was formed in 2008 to honor his parents, the foundation has made more than \$10 million in donations, the majority in Franklin and Fulton counties.



Beacon Clinic for Health and Hope

The Rolen E. and Patricia H. Ferris Foundation

A free faith-based, primary healthcare clinic serving Cumberland, Dauphin and Perry Counties, Beacon Clinic for Health and Hope received a generous contribution in 2023 from the Rolen E. and Patricia H. Ferris Foundation. In addition to their mission to eliminate hunger in the areas their dealerships serve, the Foundation also gives generously to support the Central Pennsylvania community. Regions of Harrisburg represent some of the highest rates of uninsured individuals where major barriers to healthcare access exist. The Clinic serves those who are homeless, in transition between jobs or countries, and those feeling hopeless and helpless in ill health.



Helen L. Diller Vacation Home for Blind Children

The Scott Auto Group Foundation

In 2023, the Scott Auto Group Foundation supported the Challenged Children's Charity Corporation, better known as the Helen L. Diller Vacation Home for Blind Children. Over the course of eight weeks each summer, the Home operates a camp that offers many of the campers their first experience of feeling sand in their toes or tasting salt water on their lips. The campers' range in age from seven years to fifteen years and the Home can accommodate 16 campers each week. Located in a residential community in Avalon, New Jersey, the Home has been in operation for over 50 years.



New Coat Program

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation continued its New Coat Program in 2023. More than 50,000 brand-new winter coats were distributed to needy children in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia Counties through the effort. The CARing for Kids Foundation has been organizing this community-wide initiative since 2008 and approximately 625,000 brand-new winter coats have been gifted over the years. With one in six Philadelphia-area children living in poverty and approximately 38% of households in the region struggling to make ends meet, the need for this essential item is at an all-time high. All the new coats generated through this program are distributed through a network of more than 300 nearby social services agencies, YMCAs, homeless shelters, school districts and more. This distribution process ensures that the coats get onto the backs of the children who need them most. Each year, approximately 180 local auto dealers located throughout the five-county region of Greater Philadelphia participate in the program.



Leg Up Farm

The Allan and Barbara Jennings Family Foundation

Leg Up Farm's mission is to enrich the lives of individuals and families with special needs and unique challenges through support and customized programs. In 2023, they were supported by the Allan and Barbara Jennings Family Foundation. Leg Up Farm is the only facility in the country to provide physical, occupational, speech and aquatic therapy, behavioral health services, nutrition counseling, therapeutic horsemanship, equine-assisted therapies, and educational and recreational programming under one roof and it's located in Mount Wolf, Pennsylvania, just north of York. For more than a decade, Leg Up Farm has provided life-changing services for children with special needs and their families, providing over 125,000 pediatric therapy appointments.



Big Brothers Big Sisters

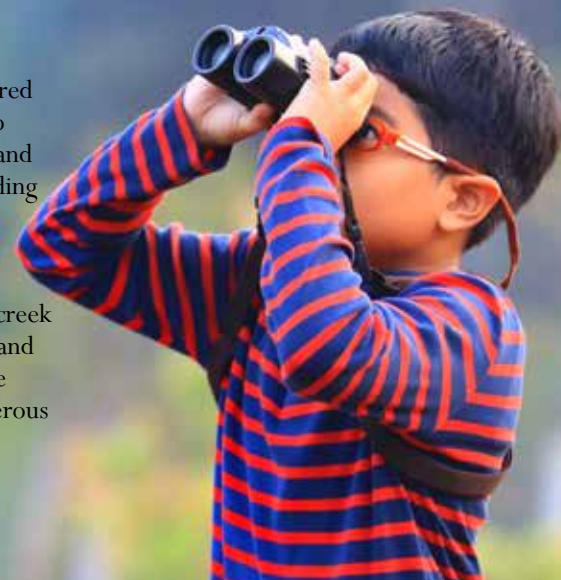
The Wind Gap Chevrolet Foundation

The first board of directors Bryan Gault ever served on – that of Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Lehigh Valley – was certainly one that had a positive effect on his life. Serving several terms throughout the 1980s, and still a dedicated supporter of the agency's two flagship events, Bowl For Kids' Sake and the annual golf tournament, Bryan and his wife, Debra, and through the Wind Gap Chevrolet Foundation, have tried to be advocates for Big Brothers Big Sisters over the years. "When we started the annual awards dinner, the stories of the Bigs and Littles didn't leave a dry eye in the place," he says. "You knew what a great program Big Brothers Big Sisters was in the Lehigh Valley." In 2023, the Wind Gap Chevrolet Foundation continued to support Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Lehigh Valley, continuing more than 40 years of giving.

The Institute at Renfrew

The Mummert Family Foundation

For more than 30 years, The Institute has created and delivered programs for students of all ages, providing opportunities to learn about their cultural and natural heritage. On the first and third Saturday of each month, organized bird walks find birding enthusiasts Sharon and Larry Williams of Waynesboro leading the walks along the hiking trails at varying locations throughout the area. The Institute's after-school program Water Striders offers youth the opportunity to "wade into" creek studies and have fun too. All program activities are outside, and each session features a different theme or topic. In 2023, the Institute at Renfrew, located in Waynesboro, received a generous contribution from the Mummert Family Foundation.



Jewish Federation of Greater Philadelphia

The Suzi and Scott Lustgarten Family Foundation

Philadelphia's Jewish community is one of the oldest in north America. For more than a century, the Jewish federation has been there to support that community by meeting urgent needs, responding to major events and strengthening Jewish traditions. Through their annual campaign, they raise funds each year to provide vital services and programs to the Jewish community, which includes proudly supporting the people of Israel, especially during times of most urgent need. In 2023, the Suzi and Scott Lustgarten Family Foundation supported the Jewish Federation of Greater Philadelphia, Friends of Ofanim, and the Holocaust Memorial Committee, among other generous gifts in the areas of healthcare and the arts.



Calvary Chapel Harrisburg - West Shore

The Bromley Family Foundation

The roots of Calvary Chapel can be found in Costa Mesa, California. A non-denominational Christian church, Calvary Chapel was founded by Pastor Chuck Smith in 1965 during a time when most traditional churches were turning away the next generation because of the length of their hair and the counter-culture lifestyle they practiced. Pastor Chuck reached out to them with love and understanding and without compromise of Christian principles. Today, with affiliate churches all over the country and the world, Calvary Chapels are still reaching out to the lost and attempting to love the unloved. They are best known for their strong emphasis on the teaching of God's Word and the application of that Word to everyday life. In 2023, Calvary Chapel Harrisburg - West Shore received generous contributions from the Bromley Family Foundation.





St. Elijah Serbian Orthodox Church

The Thomas and Cheryl Leydig Fund

The first Serb immigrants to arrive in Aliquippa in the early 1900s came from various parts of Austria-Hungary, including Banija, Kordun, Lika, Bosna, Slavonija, Srem, and Vojvodina. The St. Elijah parish remains an active and lively constituent of the Diocese of Eastern America and the Orthodox Church at large. Though the parish saw small influxes of newcomers from the former Yugoslavia after World War II and again as a result of the homeland wars in the 1990s, the majority of parishioners, whom today include over 450 supporting members and families, are descendants of the settlers who came to Aliquippa in the early 20th century. In 2023, St. Elijah Serbian Orthodox Church received a donation from the Thomas and Cheryl Leydig Fund.



Mount Aloysius College

The Matthew & Tiffany Stuckey Foundation

Mount Aloysius College is a private Catholic college in Cresson, Pennsylvania, east of Pittsburgh. It was founded in 1853 and is conducted under the tradition of the Sisters of Mercy. The college is located on a 193-acre campus in the Allegheny Mountains. In 2023, the College received a generous contribution from the Matthew & Tiffany Stuckey Foundation. Serving on the Board of Directors, Matthew Stuckey, of Stuckey Automotive, also donates his time to the college. From the sciences to the arts, there are a wide variety of majors and programs that Mountie undergraduate and graduate students can choose from. Students are given every opportunity to expand their horizons, discover their interests, and explore their passions. The Matthew & Tiffany Stuckey Foundation also gave to support Messiah University, Villanova University, area fire departments and the greater Altoona and State College Communities.

Divine Mercy Catholic Academy

The Ann Harris Smith Foundation

In 2023, the Ann Harris Smith Foundation supported the remodeling of Divine Mercy Catholic Academy East Campus' library and other accompanying educational rooms, allowing for the purchase of new books, shelves, video screens, lights, signs and more. The library portion is named the Ann Harris Smith Library, after former elementary teacher at the school and mother of Matt Smith of Laurel Auto Group (pictured at center left). A faith-based, Catholic elementary school serving families across the greater Johnstown area and surrounding communities, schools welcome students from Pre-K 3 through Grade 6 at two campuses.



Friends of Father Judge High School

The Faulkner Family Foundation

The Faulkner Family Foundation has long been a supporter of the Friends of Father Judge High School, and continued their support in 2023. Harry Faulkner, president and CEO of Faulkner Automotive, made a \$1 million commitment to the Friends of Father Judge High School in 2021 and founded the Faulkner Institute for Automotive Excellence. Students work with certified automotive technicians, who are trained mentors, to complete rigorous training and certification with the end goal of having them fully prepared to enter the workforce as a trained, and certified, automotive mechanic. The school's Career Pathways Academy Building is anchored by the Faulkner Institute for Automotive Excellence. The purpose of a Cooperative Education Program is to allow students to combine academic classroom instruction of theory and lab work with occupational instruction through learning on the job. By 2026, approximately 20 trained technicians per year will leave the school, ready to go to work at local dealerships. "This is not about us," says Harry. "It's about the school trying to broaden the students' opportunities. It's about the school being a significant part of the community." For nearly 70 years, Father Judge High School has served as an educational institution in the Philadelphia Region.



Wyomissing Area Education Foundation

The Fred and Bonnie Savage Foundation

Since its inception in 1995, the Wyomissing Area Education Foundation has provided grant money for programs, projects and equipment that have had a significant impact on students, provided funds for students needing financial assistance, and awarded numerous scholarships affecting the lives of over 200 students and community members. In addition, the foundation provides a simple way for teachers to get the supplies they need for their classrooms with a fund called the Classroom Wishes Fund. Teachers can apply for support from this fund for items found on Amazon - for things they might have otherwise purchased out of their own pockets. For several years, and continuing in 2023, the Fred and Bonnie Savage Foundation supported the Wyomissing Area Education Foundation.



Greenlight Operation

The Turner Family Foundation

In 2017, community members from South Central Pennsylvania gathered for an anti-human trafficking awareness event and were compelled to address the issue of modern-day slavery in their communities. They learned that since 2007, thousands of victims of human trafficking had been identified in Pennsylvania, yet there was sparse education and awareness about this criminal industry, and few resources for survivors. Education about human trafficking is vital to combat misinformation, empower learners, and equip community members. Now, over 150 seminars have been hosted, training police and probation officers, domestic violence and sexual assault advocates, foster care parents, social workers and legislators. In 2023, Greenlight Operation received a generous contribution from the Turner Family Foundation.



Danville Community Center

Hawkins Helping Hands

In the early 1980s, the Danville Area School District donated two acres of land where the Danville Community Center currently sits. Over the years, the Danville Community Center has grown to provide needed services to the greater community. The Center serves the community through educational, social, cultural, and physical wellness. It envisions a community where all members have a lifetime of fellowship and wellness. Programs include after-school care, fitness classes, a pool, senior programs, and sports facilities. In 2023, Hawkins Helping Hands continued their long-time support of the Danville Community Center.

Breezewood Volunteer Fire Co.

The Judy Faulkner and Art Riexinger Foundation

The Breezewood community is located in Bedford County in south-central Pennsylvania. For a long time, Breezewood was a popular stopping place for automobile travelers on the Lincoln Highway, beginning in 1913. Breezewood, with a faded sign proclaiming it the "Town of Motels" and the "Traveler's Oasis", boomed after the Pennsylvania Turnpike opened in 1940. Breezewood Volunteer Fire Company provides emergency fire and rescue services to the local community through programs such as fire protection and emergency rescue services. Fifty-four percent of firefighters in the United States are volunteers and contributions help the fire company to acquire and operate the firefighting apparatus, equip and train the firefighters, maintain the firehouse, and often also covers insurance, worker's compensation, and other post-injury or retirement benefits for the volunteers. In 2023, the Judy Faulkner and Art Riexinger Foundation generously supported the Breezewood Volunteer Fire Company.



Caring Cupboard

The Lewis Family Foundation

The Caring Cupboard is committed to supporting individuals and families facing food insecurity in the Palmyra and Annville-Cleona communities. In 2023, Caring Cupboard took on a significant role in addressing food insecurity by assuming Jonestown Outreach Food Pantry in Lebanon County. The Caring Cupboard envisions a community where friends and neighbors have access to nutritious food, commit to health and hunger education, and build a supportive space for a stronger, healthier community for all. In 2023, the Caring Cupboard received a generous donation from the Lewis Family Foundation,



Veteran's Multi Service Center

The David P. Kelleher and Marlo Pagano-Kelleher Foundation

A nationally recognized non-profit organization providing comprehensive services to veterans since 1980, VMC's mission is to provide programs, opportunity and advancement to veterans of the U.S military and their families. It was founded in 1980 by local Vietnam Veterans who built a memorial along the Philadelphia waterfront and discovered a sense of community unparalleled. Proudly serving 23-out-of-67 Pennsylvania counties, VMC offers its services in Pennsylvania, one of the largest states with among the highest Veteran populations nationally. Their focus is on sustainable housing, combating hunger, restoring benefits and helping veterans find gainful employment. In 2023, Veteran's Multi Service Center received a generous donation from the David P. Kelleher and Marlo Pagano-Kelleher Foundation.

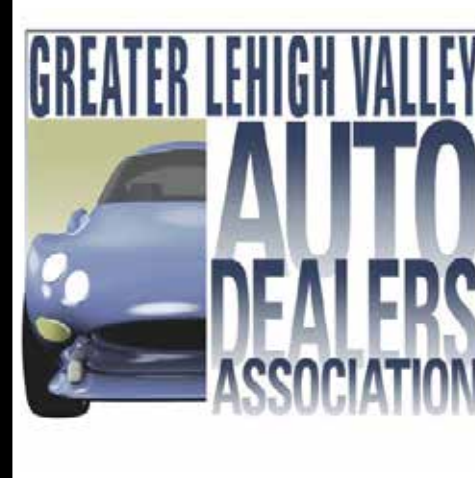

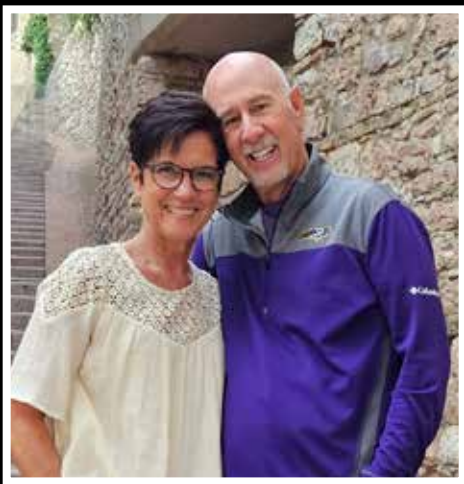
