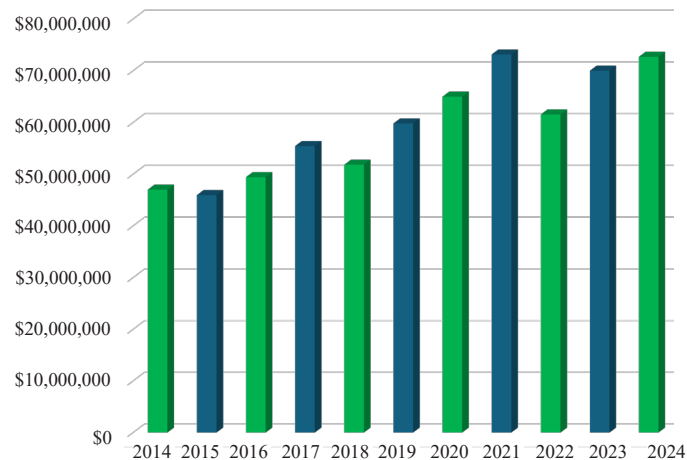

Fund Balance History



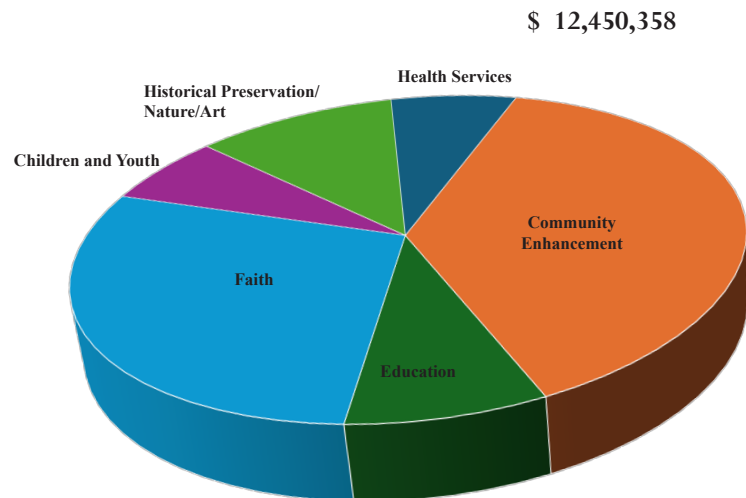
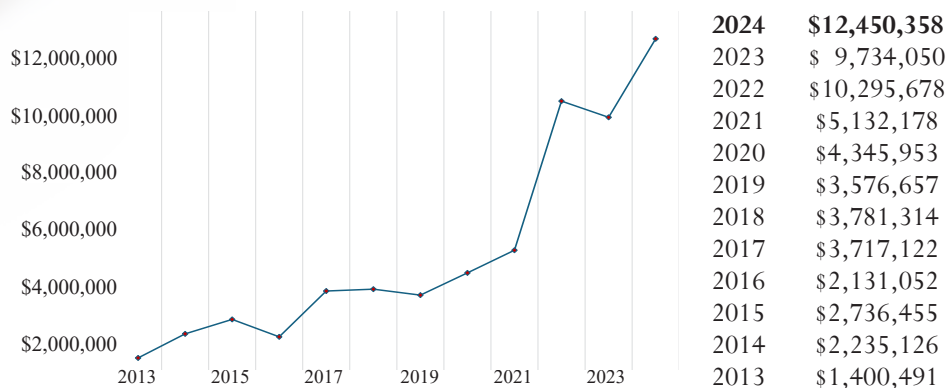

St. Jude Children's Research Hospital

The Robert and Gail Hunter Foundation

In 2024, the Robert and Gail Hunter Foundation generously supported St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, a pediatric treatment and research hospital headquartered in Memphis, Tennessee. St. Jude's reputation is world renown and their commercials are inspiring. Their story is inspiring too. In 1962, with help from Dr. Lemuel Diggs and close friend Anthony Abraham, an auto magnate in Miami, Florida, entertainer Danny Thomas founded St. Jude. As a starving young actor, he had pledged that if he found success, he would open a shrine dedicated to St. Jude Thaddeus, one of the patron saints of hopeless causes. His career spanned decades. Today, St. Jude Children's Research Hospital focuses on children's catastrophic diseases, particularly leukemia and other cancers. 74% percent of St. Jude's total budget comes from donations, and the hospital costs about \$1.7 million per day to run. Over the years, St. Jude has helped push the overall survival rate for childhood cancer from 20% to 80%.



Windber Medical Center

The Ann Harris Smith Foundation

The Ann Harris Smith Foundation continued their support of Windber Medical Center in 2024. Following the COVID Pandemic, The Ann Harris Smith Foundation and Chan Soon-Shiong Medical Center at Windber, partnered to promote "Screen One Screen All", an awareness campaign created to encourage women to schedule their health exams. Recognizing the importance of screening for all female cancers and sharing a commitment to women's health brought the hospital together with the Ann Harris Smith Foundation, which was started in 2000 after Ann Harris Smith was diagnosed with Stage IV ovarian cancer. The foundation enthusiastically agreed to collaborate on the "Screen One Screen All" campaign, bringing an even larger focus to its goal of increasing ovarian cancer awareness. "The Smith Family has done an amazing job of increasing awareness of ovarian cancer in our area and we hope to help them continue those efforts through the women's health services offered at Chan Soon-Shiong Medical Center at Windber," said President & CEO Tom Kurtz.

Mikey Faulkner Dental Care Center

The Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation

People with cognitive, developmental, or physical disabilities often have trouble getting effective and excellent dental care. Penn Dental Medicine at Woods is different. Located in suburban Langhorne, the Mikey Faulkner Dental Care center features a calm, quiet setting. The special needs dental care suite makes treatment safe and as stress-free as possible for every patient. Patients receive premier dental treatment from a staff of professionals specifically trained to care for people with physical, cognitive, or developmental disabilities. The Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation is a great supporter of Woods Services, a health network and advocacy organization that provides life-long innovative, comprehensive and integrated health, education, housing, workforce, behavioral health and case management services to more than 22,000 children and adults in the intellectual and developmental disability, child welfare, behavioral and brain trauma public health sectors who have complex and intensive medical and behavioral healthcare needs.



York Opioid Collaborative

The Giambalvo Family Foundation

Following a spike in heroin related overdoses, deaths, and crime related to its resurgence in early 2014, Chief Deputy Prosecutor (now Attorney General) Dave Sunday and York County Coroner Pam Gay formed the York County Heroin Task Force, now the York Opioid Collaborative. The initial goals were to reduce the demand for heroin and illegally used prescription drugs, educate citizens, and reduce drug-related crime. Opioid abuse and overdoses deaths are best addressed by a multi-sector group, focused on broader issues that require sustained effort. The York Opioid Collaborative, in partnership with the City of York Bureau of Health, has developed a program to help community agencies in encouraging and supporting individuals to safely store medications and properly dispose of unused or expired medications. This service is provided free of charge to community agencies and is a component of their safe prescribing initiative. The Collaborative also supports Naloxone training and strategies to coordinate overdose prevention efforts through First Responder Programs.

Driving Away the Cold

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation held its 17th Annual Driving Away the Cold New Coat Program in 2024. More than 50,000 brand-new winter coats were distributed to needy children in Bucks, Chester, Delaware, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties through this effort. The Foundation has been organizing this community-wide initiative since 2008 and approximately 675,000 brand-new winter coats have been gifted as a result. Nearly 180 local auto dealers located throughout the five-county region of Greater Philadelphia participated in the program. All the new coats generated through this program are distributed through a network of more than 250 nearby social services agencies, YMCAs, homeless shelters, school districts and more. This distribution process ensures that the coats get onto the backs of the children who need them most.



Girls Spark

The Scott and Lucinda Friedman Foundation

Girls Spark is an organization created by teen girls for teen girls in the Delaware Valley and beyond. Their mission is to provide middle and high school girls with a safe, supportive empowering environment where they can learn, collaborate and overcome adversity in facing today's social issues. In 2018, high-schooler Julia Kasper created Girls Spark in order to make a positive difference in the lives of young women. Throughout her life, she watched her mom, a President and CEO of her own business, attend various women's conferences, featuring inspiring leaders. She searched for something similar to that speaks to the issues teen girls face but found nothing. Programs include school clubs, workshops and an annual summit. In 2024, Girls Spark received a grant from the Scott and Lucinda Friedman Foundation.





Work to Ride

The J.L. Freed Foundation

In 2024, the J.L. Freed Foundation generously supported Work to Ride, which provides activities that promote discipline, self-esteem, motivation, social development, life skills, academic achievement and physical fitness through year-round equestrian programs that encourage long term participation. The program aids Philadelphia's under-resourced youth through constructive activities centered on horsemanship, equine sports and education. Housed at Chamounix Equestrian Center, located in West Fairmount Park, Philadelphia, the setting provides a unique opportunity to bring Philadelphia's youth in contact with animals and nature.

Max's Kicks 4 Kids

The Scott Auto Group Foundation

Providing new back-to-school shoes for children in need in Southeastern Pennsylvania and surrounding areas, Max's Kicks 4 Kids is a family run charity that started in 2019 following the death of Max, a young probation officer in Chester County. Last year, Max's Kicks 4 Kids provided approximately 500 pairs of new, brand name sneakers to kids and families throughout Chester County, up from 30 in 2019. The charity has started a golf outing in support of their mission. In 2024, the Scott Auto Group Foundation supported Max's Kicks 4 Kids.

Jaws Youth Playbook

The David P. Kelleher and Marlo Pagano-Kelleher Foundation

Jaws Youth Playbook is the foundation of Former Eagles QB and NFL Analyst, Ron Jaworski and his wife, Liz Jaworski. The non-profit has been working hard to improve the overall health and wellness of at-risk youth in the Greater Philadelphia Region for over 40 years. It invests in children and their future through building playgrounds and ballfields, providing much needed sports equipment, supporting summer meal programs and healthy nutrition in underserved communities. In 2024, Jaws Youth Playbook was generously supported by the David P. Kelleher and Marlo Pagano-Kelleher Foundation.

Friends of SummerSounds

The Mohler Family Foundation

SummerSounds is a free, family-friendly series of outdoor concerts featuring a wide variety of contemporary music performed by national touring acts. Shows are at 7:00 pm every Friday in June, July and August at Street Clair Park in Greensburg and have been for the past 23 years. The groups are varied, and it is a great venue to sit and have a glass of wine and enjoy good music and friends. Before 2024, the concert series was largely run by volunteers but now has an events manager. The role is a new position for the iconic community organization which was added as part of a merger between SummerSounds and the Greensburg Community Development Corporation. In 2024, SummerSounds received a generous grant from the Mohler Family Foundation.

Hagerstown Aviation Museum

The Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation

In 2024, the Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation supported the creation and expansion of exhibits at the Hagerstown Aviation Museum, including the relocation of the archives and library and the creation of classrooms. It also supported the creation of the Paul K. Shockey Aircraft Factory Experience, located in the 7,400-square-foot “annex building” adjoining the dome hangar. With its original sawtooth roof and windows, this exhibit will mirror a “day-in-the-life” of a Fairchild Factory employee and will offer a myriad of hands-on, STEM-specific activities featuring some of the museum’s more than 15,000 artifacts. The idea for an aviation museum in Hagerstown originated in 1995 during the Fairchild Homecoming Air Show. This event featured historic Fairchild aircraft and the individuals who built them. On September 27, 2020, after many years of looking for a home for the museum, the museum signed a lease for the 1943 Fairchild Aircraft Flight Test Hangar also known as the Dome Hangar. The lease signing, with an option to buy, saved the historic structure from an uncertain future and possible demolition





Fair Lane Estate: Home of Clara & Henry Ford

The Fox Family Foundation

Fair Lane was the estate of Ford Motor Company founder Henry Ford and his wife, Clara Ford, in Dearborn, Michigan. The 1,300-acre estate along the River Rouge included a large limestone house, an electrical power plant on the river, a greenhouse, a boathouse, riding stables, a children's playhouse, a treehouse, and extensive landmark gardens designed by Chicago landscape architect Jens Jensen. In 2013, a 501c3 non-profit organization was established to restore and re-imagine Clara and Henry's beloved estate and ensure their legacy endures.

When Thomas Edison joined Henry Ford at Fair Lane to lay the cornerstone of the powerhouse and garage over 100 years ago, a design and engineering marvel was born. Soon after, Fair Lane's generators began providing the estate and much of the surrounding area with a clean, renewable source of hydroelectric power. It was also the special place where Henry tinkered and experimented in his on-site laboratory and would repair watches for local Dearborn residents. Together with their beloved home, the powerhouse and garage at Fair Lane complete the story of Clara and Henry's commitment to family, nature, and progress.

The leadership and support by Ford and Lincoln dealers across North America has enabled much of the home to be expertly restored. In 2024, Fair Lane Estate received a generous contribution from the Fox Family Foundation.

Lehigh Valley Outreach Depot

The Rentschler Family Foundation

The Lehigh Valley Outreach Depot provides gently used furniture and housewares to people of the Lehigh Valley who have experienced devastating losses through fire, flood, homelessness, and domestic violence. Charitable donations of items to help support the ministry are always welcome, and donations of funds are needed to underwrite the costs of warehouse space, utilities, office supplies, disaster relief supplies as well as truck operation and maintenance. In addition, the Depot organizes the assembly of disaster relief kits to provide basic necessities for people throughout the United States during times of crisis. In 2024, the Lehigh Valley Outreach Depot received generous support from the Rentschler Family Foundation.



CPT Connor J. Bednarzyk, USA Memorial Fund

The Ciocca Family Foundation

CPT Connor J. Bednarzyk was an inspiring and proud product of the Buckingham Community. He spent his elementary and secondary educational years in the Central Bucks School District and participated in local youth sports programs. As a student and Army Officer, he embraced his Buckingham roots by demonstrating leadership, compassion, and inclusiveness. CPT Bednarzyk was killed on September 7, 2018, during a training mission near Ft. Benning, Georgia. The Fund started in his honor has a mission to encourage and assist individuals who will serve, are serving, or have served our Country by enlisting in the Armed Forces of the United States. It provides high school scholarships, grants to other nonprofit corporations aiding veterans with PTSD, and offers support to those participating in Ranger Training Phases. In 2024, the CPT. Connor J. Bednarzyk USA Memorial Fund received a generous gift from the Ciocca Family Foundation.





Creek Cleanup Project

The Allan and Barbara Jennings Family Foundation

Creek Cleanup Project has taken an aggressive and necessary approach to cleaning up the creeks of Franklin County. To date, they have covered 67 miles of the East Branch of the Conococheague Creek removing well over 100,000 lbs of trash and 26 miles of the West Branch removing over 4,000 lbs of trash. No item is too big or too small in their efforts to return the creek to its natural state. With future plans to grow into aquatic wildlife education, paddling safety courses, and boat rentals, the Creek Cleanup Project is dedicated to restoring the beauty of nature and preventing trash from high traffic areas from spreading miles downstream. In 2024, the Creek Cleanup Project was supported by the Allan and Barbara Jennings Family Foundation.

Cay Galgon Life House

The Motts Family Foundation

In 2012, the Cay Galgon Life House opened at the former St. Simon and Jude Convent, providing a space for pregnant women and their babies. The former convent was renovated into a beautiful group home with seven rooms for homeless pregnant women. From the beginning, this home has been central to their work, where the focus has been on healthy pregnancies, educational and vocation support, and housing. Their Residential Program provides safe, transitional housing for pregnant women and new moms experiencing homelessness, offering support throughout pregnancy and up to two years postpartum. In addition, the Community Outreach Program serves pregnant women and new mothers with infants under 12 months old who are in need, offering essential resources and support during the critical transition from pregnancy to postpartum. They provide basic baby necessities (diapers, wipes, clothing, baby equipment), consumable goods, and agency referrals to support families in need. In 2024, the Cay Galgon Life House received a grant from the Motts Family Foundation.
