Children's Hospital of Philadelphia

The Suzi and Scott Lustgarten Family Foundation

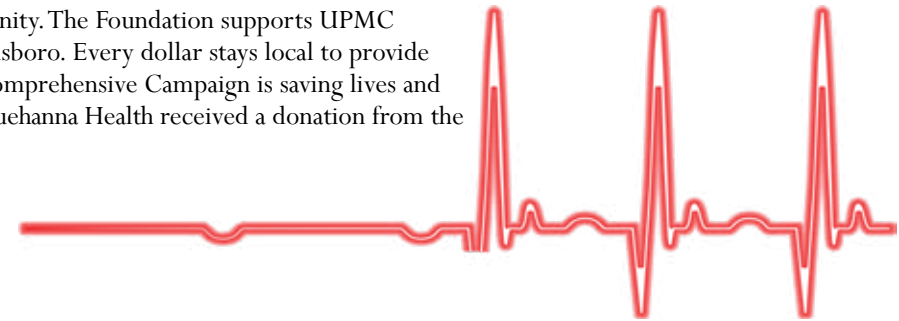
In 2021, the Suzi and Scott Lustgarten Foundation generously gave to Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP). The Lustgartens have a long history of supporting CHOP and the Suzi and Scott Lustgarten Center for GI Motility. Established in 2011, the Lustgarten Center offers the nation's most comprehensive clinical and research program in pediatric gastrointestinal motility disorders. The Center operates within the Division of Gastroenterology, Hepatology and Nutrition. In children with GI motility disorders, the esophagus, stomach or intestines do not function normally. The cause of these problems can be difficult to pinpoint, making both diagnosis and treatment complex. At the Lustgarten Center, patients and their families find a unique multidisciplinary, patient-centered approach that integrates medical, physiological and psychological expertise in evaluation and treatment that is tailored to each child's individual diagnoses. The Suzi and Scott Lustgarten Family Foundation also gave to Trustees of the University of Pennsylvania Hospital, the American Heart Association, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, and the Prostate Cancer Foundation, among other grants.



Susquehanna Health

The William P. and Lorraine Manos Foundation

Susquehanna Health Foundation connects the passions of donors with the health care needs of the community. The Foundation supports UPMC hospitals in North Central Pennsylvania including facilities in Lock Haven, Muncy, Williamsport, and Wellsboro. Every dollar stays local to provide life-changing medicine close to home. With a fundraising goal of \$11 Million, the Susquehanna Strong Comprehensive Campaign is saving lives and improving health. Areas of focus include the UPMC Hillman Cancer Center in Williamsport. In 2021, Susquehanna Health received a donation from the William P. and Lorraine Manos Foundation to support their life-saving services.



Penn State Health Dermatology

The Lewis Family Foundation

The Lewis Family Foundation donated to Penn State Health to establish and benefit the Lewis Family Community Health Endowment in Dermatology, in honor of Dr. Elizabeth Billingsley. Dr. Billingsley's research specialty is melanoma and skin cancer. Melanoma is a leading cause of death from skin disease – more than 70% of skin cancer deaths are from melanoma and each year it becomes more common. The Multidisciplinary Skin Cancer clinic at Penn State Cancer Institute specializes in treating melanoma and other skin cancers.

The Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation

The Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation gave generously in 2021 to support healthcare systems including Fox Chase Cancer Center, Bryn Mawr Hospital, and Children's Hospital of Philadelphia (CHOP). With support from donors like the Joseph and Mary Faulkner Family Foundation, healthcare systems could work through the complexities of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic and sustain their critical services in times of need.



Schreiber Pediatric Rehab Center of Lancaster County

The Allen Family Foundation

The Schreiber Center for Pediatric Development has been a benchmark provider to children and adults with disabilities since 1936. The organization, originally known as the Society for Crippled Children and Adults, was formed as a response to the polio epidemic by concerned community members. It was later known as the National Easter Seals Society, with Edna Schreiber spearheading the organization's success as its executive director for 31 years, through 1967. During the late 1980s, the organization began to shift its focus toward specialized pediatric therapy services for infants, children, and adolescents with developmental delays and disabilities. Today, offering physical, occupational and speech-language therapy, they treat any child in need, regardless of the family's ability to pay. In 2021, the Allen Family Foundation supported the rehab center and many organizations benefiting their community.

Sophia Sunshine Foundation

The Faulkner Family Foundation

Sophia Southerling, age 7, of Jenkintown, Pennsylvania passed away on November 28, 2020 after fighting a courageous 15-month battle of a rare form of brain cancer called DIPG. To honor her memory, friends and family created Sophia Sunshine, a charity that would support research towards a cure for DIPG. The organization also supports Sophia's favorite interests – horses, dogs, and reading. Sophia Sunshine collects new children's books every day for distribution to children in hospice so their parents and loved ones can read to them. Funds are also directed to equine therapy and service dog sponsorship. In 2021, the Sophia Sunshine Foundation received a generous donation from the Faulkner Family Foundation. The Faulkner Family Foundation also supports Abington Friends School, the Friends of Father Judge High School, and the Greater Philadelphia YMCA among other organizations.



Operation Warm

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation

The Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation passed a major milestone in 2021 – the distribution of its 500,000th brand-new winter coat to a local child in need. With support from 175 dealers in the greater Philadelphia area and other auto industry stakeholders, the CARing for Kids Foundation has given the gift of warmth and confidence to 516,444 impoverished children since 2008. That's the equivalent of \$8 million in new coats! Providing a new coat is important because quality equals dignity, even for kids. The Philadelphia area dealers and their foundation have had a tremendous impact on the most vulnerable members of their community.





Ronald McDonald House

The Greater Pittsburgh Automobile Dealers Association Foundation

The Greater Pittsburgh Automobile Dealers Association Foundation continued its commitment to the mission of the Ronald McDonald House Charities of Pittsburgh and Morgantown by serving as the charity's 2021 Presenting Mission Partner, ensuring that families continue to receive the very best in care, comfort and support during their stay. Annually, over 500 families stayed at RMHC Pittsburgh and Morgantown, giving families a place to sleep, find a hot shower and eat a home-cooked meal all while being only steps away from their child's medical care. The Greater Pittsburgh Automobile Dealers Association Foundation has been an avid supporter of the charity over the years.

Dwell Orphan Care

The Matt & Tiff Stuckey Foundation

Dwell Orphan Care supports foster and adoptive families in Lycoming County so that children have a safe, loving, forever home in which to dwell. Dwell works to empower, equip and encourage local churches and the community to come alongside foster and adoptive families with intention and encouragement. With an army of love and a network of support around them, foster and adoptive families remain committed and can focus on raising emotionally connected children whose lives are full of hope and promise for the future. Dwell provides clothing and necessities to help children through the initial trauma and transition to foster care, support and mentorship for new foster parents, care packages, and training support services. The Matt and Tiff Stuckey Foundation is a great supporter of children and youth in their community also giving to Salt 'n Light Youth Ministry, Young Life, and numerous organizations that support the greater Altoona area.



Big Brothers Big Sisters

The Landis Family Foundation

Little brother Hector was struggling with being bullied and completing his school work, especially reading and writing. After six months of being mentored by Big brother Elijah, his grades and peer relationships dramatically improved. In his own words, "I love my new friends and reading is actually kind of fun!" Bigs (mentors) spend time with Littles (ages 7-18) two to four times a month and build a friendship through a variety of activities such as playing games, getting ice cream, sharing a hobby or just hanging out and talking. Each match is unique and develops a schedule that works for them. 100% of matched Littles in the Lehigh Valley since 2019 have remained uninvolved in the juvenile justice system. Big Brothers Big Sisters of the Lehigh Valley has made a significant impact in the community and continues to support children in need. In 2021, Big Brother Big Sisters of the Lehigh Valley received a donation from the Landis Family Foundation, who also gave to Communities in Schools of Eastern Pennsylvania, Victory House of the Lehigh Valley, and several charities supporting rescue animals.



National Forest Foundation

The Rentschler Family Foundation

Chartered by Congress, the National Forest Foundation was created with a simple mission: bring people together to restore and enhance our National Forests and Grasslands. National Forests and Grasslands provide Americans with 193 million spectacular acres of wildlands. The National Forest Foundation provides the chance to see elk and bear, ducks and deer, trout and trees, thousands of species of plants, and billions of stars in a midnight sky. In 2021, the National Forest Foundation received a grant from the Rentschler Family Foundation.

Lancaster Farm Trust

The James and Virginia Jones Foundation

Protecting farmland preserves Lancaster's way of life, provides bountiful fresh, local foods, and improves water supply through on-farm conservation practices. In 2021, with 50 farms on its waiting list, Lancaster Farmland Trust launched its "Honoring the Promise" campaign – a \$7.5 million initiative to preserve 50 farms totaling 4,000 acres of rich, productive Lancaster County farmland. The James and Virginia Jones Foundation continued their support of Lancaster Farm Trust in 2021.

Kentucky Tornado Relief

The Judy Faulkner and Art Riexinger Foundation

Governor Beshear established the Team Western Kentucky Tornado Relief Fund to assist those impacted by the tornadoes on December 10-11, 2021, when a violent, long-tracked tornado moved across Western Kentucky, producing severe to catastrophic damage in numerous towns. At least 53 people were killed by the swarm of tornadoes that tore a 200-mile path, demolishing homes, leveling businesses and setting off a scramble to find survivors beneath the rubble. Team Western Kentucky received a generous contribution from the Judy Faulkner and Art Riexinger Foundation.

Colonial Williamsburg

The Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation

In 2021, the Paul K. and Anna E. Shockey Family Foundation donated to the Colonial Williamsburg Foundation to create the Ken and Bonnie Shockey Endowment for the Historic Trades. Nowhere else in America or Europe can you go to learn so much about traditional, preindustrial trades except the streets of the historic area. The Colonial Williamsburg Foundation researches and replicates eighteenth-century Anglo-American technology, perpetuating historic trades. Some survive only because of the foundation's long-term dedication to preserving human skills. The tradespeople are professional, full-time artisans dedicated to specific occupations, practicing them publicly, and sharing their knowledge with guests. Some of the best traditional artisans in the country work at Colonial Williamsburg. Combining their range of skills and the variety of products they can produce, the program re-creates a realistic model of eighteenth-century production systems. Colonial Williamsburg is the only institution that can construct a carriage or build and furnish a house, from the ground up, using almost exclusively eighteenth-century materials, tools, and skills.



Appell Center for the Performing Arts

The Giambalvo Family Foundation

The Appell Center for the Performing Arts features two historic theaters – the Strand Theatre built in 1925 and the Capitol Theatre built in 1906 – each with its own unique history. Built for over \$1 million, the Strand Theatre prospered during the days of vaudeville and silent film in the roaring 1920s. The Capitol Theatre was built as a one level dance hall, with the balcony added in 1917 for films. Partnerships with corporations and local businesses are essential to the Appell Center for the Performing Arts, whose mission is not only to bring the best-in-class entertainment to Central Pennsylvania but also to provide superior performing arts education for the community. In 2021, the Appell Center for the Performing Arts received a generous grant from the Giambalvo Family Foundation.

Philabundance

The David P. Kelleher and Marlo Pagano-Kelleher Foundation

Philabundance is the largest hunger relief organization in the Delaware Valley. What started in 1984 as a small food rescue organization operating out of one car is now an innovative and collaborative organization distributing millions of pounds of food a year to those in need. In February of 2021, David Kelleher assisted in an effort to provide meals to food workers impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic, and the David P. Kelleher and Marlo Pagano-Kelleher Foundation generously donated to the effort. In 2021, they also supported City Team Chester, North10 Philadelphia, and various organizations benefiting children in need.



Waynesburg Franklin Fire Company

The Fox Family Foundation

In 2021, the Fox Family Foundation donated to Waynesburg Franklin Fire Company. In addition to financial support, some of the volunteer firefighters include the Fox brothers, Ron, Dave, Mark and Tim. Their father, Bob, and grandfather Ollie also volunteered with the station back in their day, and now a younger generation of the Fox's sons and nephews have stepped in as volunteers. Waynesburg-Franklin Township VFC provides fire protection and rescue services for Waynesburg Borough along with Franklin, Washington and Whiteley Townships. The fire company covers 110 square miles, responds to 240 emergency calls per year and trains more than 350 hours per year.



Unite for HER

The Scott Auto Group Foundation

When Unite for HER founder Sue Weldon was diagnosed with breast cancer in 2004, she began searching for information on therapies that would complement the medical treatments she was receiving. What she discovered was a lack of easily accessible resources on topics like nutrition, acupuncture, massage, yoga, counseling and other ways for breast cancer patients to enhance their wellness and care for their emotional, spiritual, and physical needs. In 2021, the Scott Auto Group Foundation generously supported Unite for HER.

Zelienople Revitalization

The Gregg and Jenny Semel Foundation

The charm of Zelienople, often referred to as “Zelie,” is a shared appreciation for the town’s rich history among a community of like-minded people who thrive on the security and sense of belonging that comes with living in a small town. Along Zelienople’s Main Street sits the town’s business district, which is by and large occupied by family-owned businesses. As in many small towns, however, Zelienople’s business sector has had to navigate modern commercial competition and other developments that present challenges. Zelienople officials took notice about seven years ago of the increasing number of empty storefronts. Borough council members and business leaders created Zelienople PA Revitalization, a nonprofit organization that promotes locally-owned businesses on Main Street while working on strengthening Zelienople’s commercial district. Gregg Semel was first elected to Zelienople Borough Council in 2013 and, through the Gregg and Jenny Semel Foundation, is a great supporter of the community.

Elmwood Park Zoo

The Wynn Family Foundation

The Wynn Family donated to Elmwood Park Zoo in 2021. The gift is in support of the zoo’s efforts to expand its development across Stony Creek. Elmwood Park Zoo’s future expansion relies on being able to access the more than 20 acres of land that run adjacent to the zoo’s current footprint. Elmwood Park Zoo was established in 1924 when a local farmer transferred 16 acres and a small menagerie to the Borough of Norristown. Elmwood Park Zoo currently maintains a collection of over 100 species that hail from all over the globe. Highlights of the collection include giraffes, zebras, bald and golden eagles, jaguars, and red pandas. The Wynn Family Foundation also generously gave to the Auto Dealers CARing for Kids Foundation, the Salvation Army of Philadelphia, Daily Bread Community Food Pantry, among others.

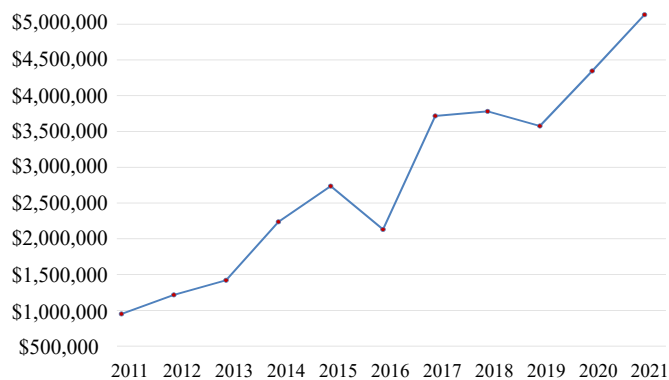

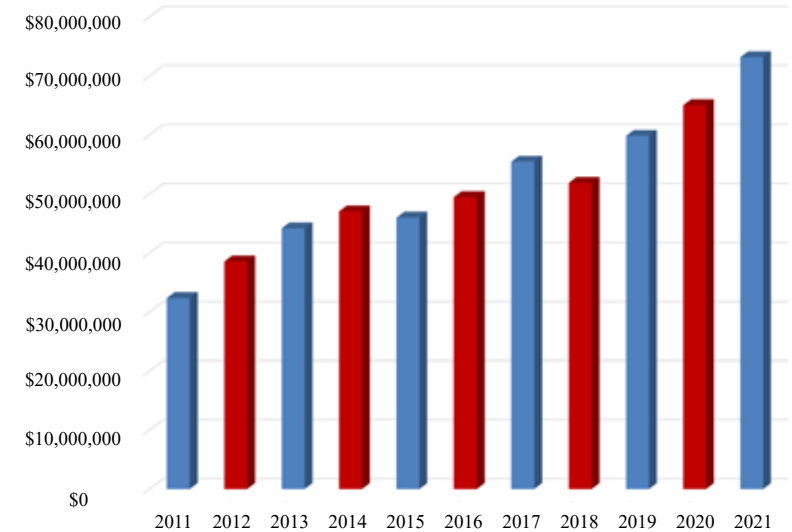

Increase in Grants Distributed to Charities by Year



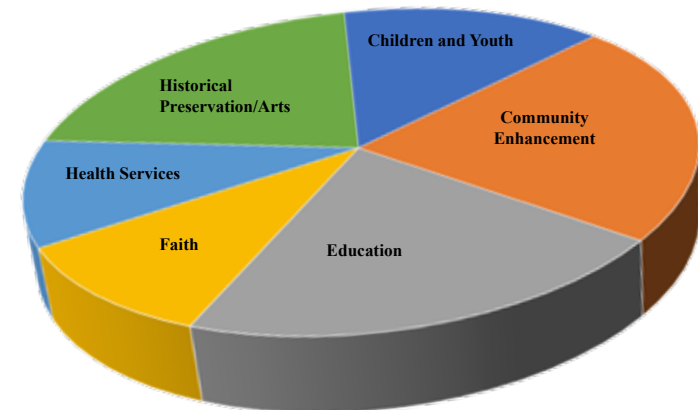
